Each company vies with the other to arrive first at the conflagration, each man rushes to his post of duty, each tries to be first to enter the burning building, each man tries to show his contempt of danger and each tries to outdo his brother man in deeds of heroism. Such are the every day occurrences in the life of our greatest of all protectors, the blue shirted firemen.

The San Pedro Volunteer Fire Department was organized in the year 1895 with sixty-five members which were divided into five companies, three hose companies with about six hundred feet of cotton hose each, one hook and ladder company and one chemical engine company, all the apparatus being hand power. The water is supplied from a reservoir by a private corporation.

It may be said also that many of the large corporations owning wharves along the harbor, have fire fighting apparatus of their own which gives much more protection to the Harbor City than many other cities of far greater population. But the fact that the department is one of the most complete volunteer organizations of the kind on the coast and the men among the most efficient in their line of duty is the secret that saves money for the insurance companies and makes San Pedro so proud of her Fire Department. Its promptness and efficiency in staying the ravages of the fire king have often been the subject for congratulatory reflection on the part of the citizens whose lives and property are benefited.

Fire protection consists mainly in stopping a fire at its earliest inception, and the remarkable immunity from serious conflagrations that the records show San Pedro to have had, speaks well for the efficiency of this city's department in being prompt to respond to every call.

This city is as vulnerable as others. Alarms are numerous, as the records will show, and the men are called on quite frequently, and while the total losses are comparatively insignificant it is well to bear in mind that the only hope of safety from large fires lies in eternal vigilance.

The rates of insurance are based largely upon the protection provided, and few cities can show such a saving in insurance charges as have been granted here. However, so far as the safe-guarding of property goes, only a small part of the value of a city's fire department is shown in the reduction of fire losses. It is wrong to gauge the need of fire protection or the amount of it to be provided by either a table of fire losses or such concessions as underwriters may make. A city's fire department should be maintained against probable great emergencies much as Uncle Sam supplies a navy, even though in years there may be little need of one, and the citizens should not allow the absence of the destructive element for a few months to lull them into a dream of fancied security, from which they might be rudely awakened by the clang of the gong at any hour of the day or night.

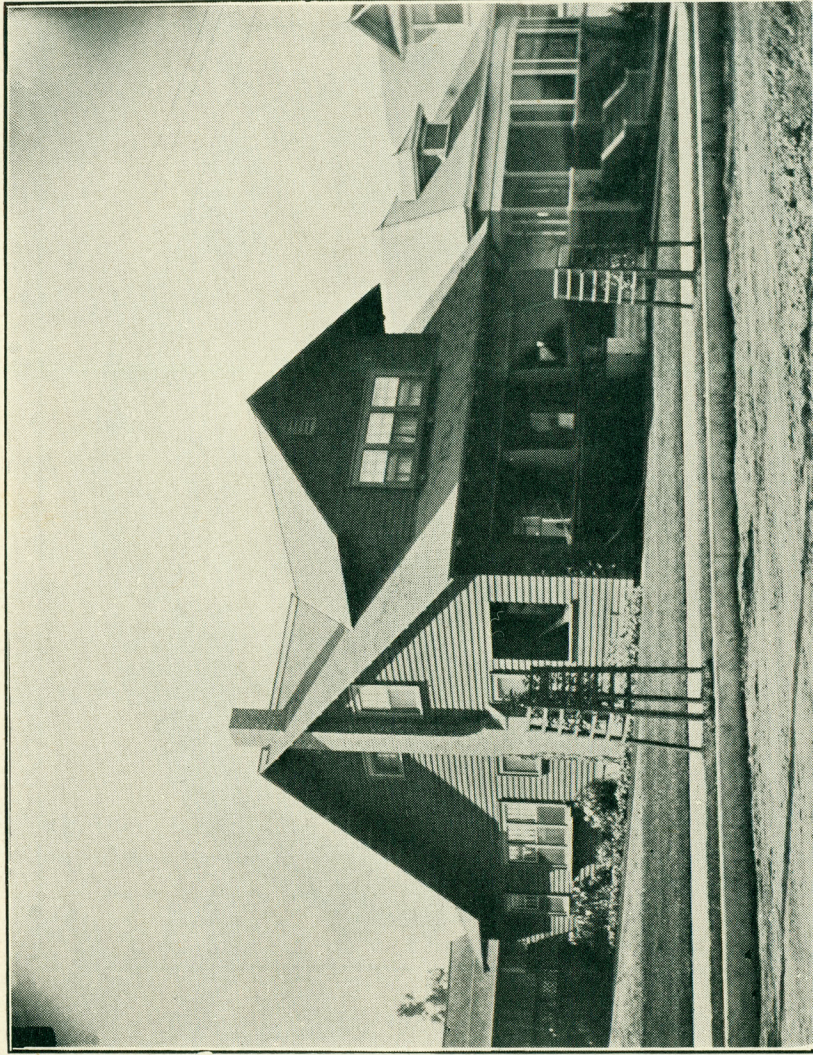


LOS ANGELES COUNTY COURT HOUSE

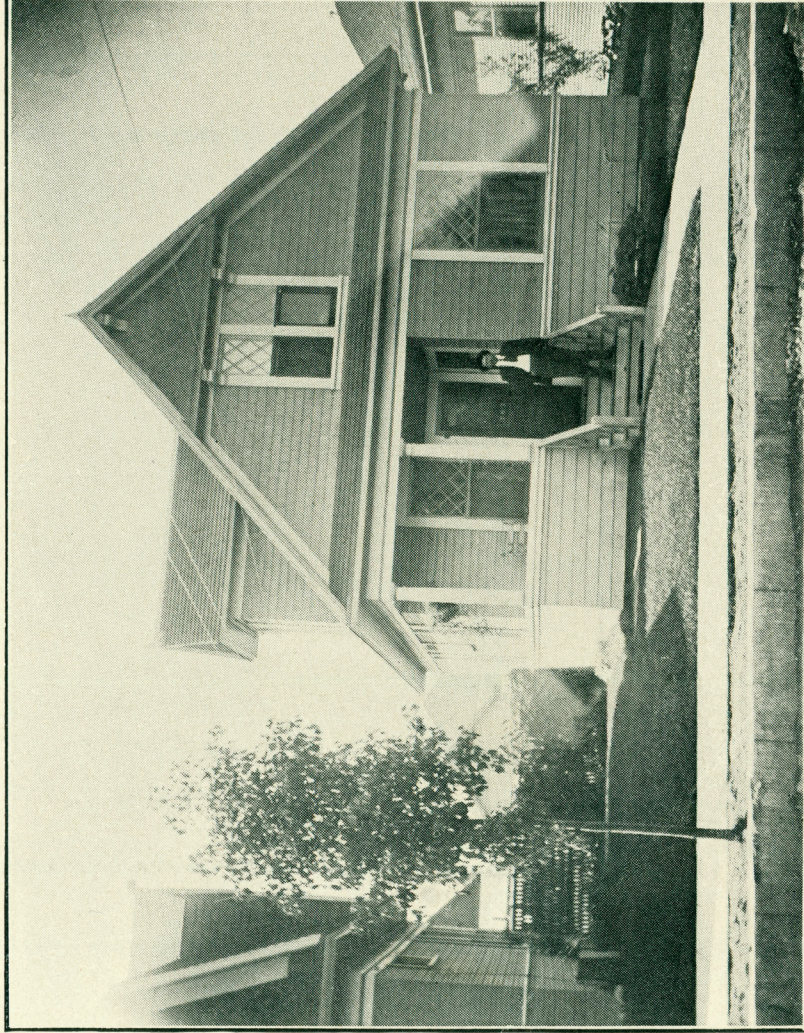

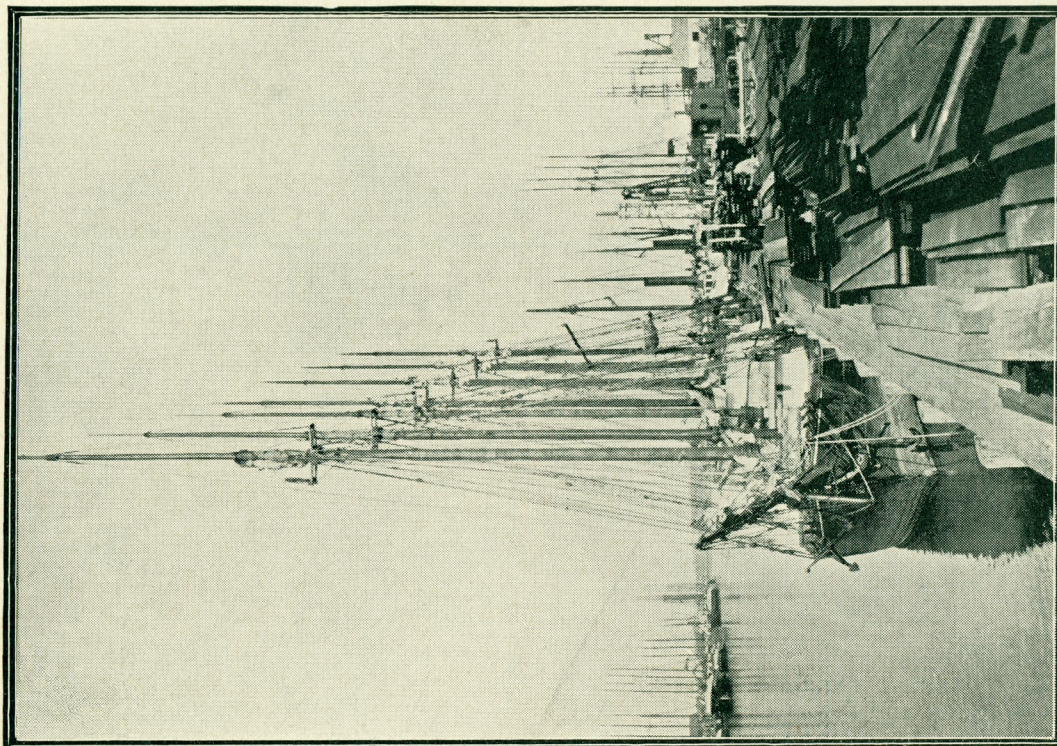
